

1-1.A PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

REQUIREMENT

1-1.A Sites have a description of: 1) eligibility criteria, 2) data used to determine criteria, 3) geographic service area, and 4) # of families the site has capacity to serve. Criteria are based on data from one or more sources.

How is this rated?

- Exceeds Standard (3) eligibility criteria description includes everything outlined above and data used includes the <u>source and year</u>.
 - Description & data reviewed by site's Community Advisory Board (CAB) within past 2 years
- **Meets Standard (2)** same as 3 rating, except the description & data have been reviewed by the site's CAB within the <u>past 4 years</u>
- Does not Yet Meet Standard (1) site does not yet have this description, it is missing one of the required pieces, or CAB has not reviewed in the past 4 years.

DOCUMENTATION REVIEW

1) Sites submit a narrative* that should include:	
☐ The eligibility criteria	☐ Data used (including both the source and year)
Geographic service area	# of families expected to be served annually
2) Sites share evidence of Advisory Board review w/in the last 4 years (e.g., minutes)

TIPS FOR COMPLETING

- Data used may come from a variety of sources such as hospital birth #s, kidscount.org, vital records, census.gov
- Engage in discussions with the CAB on how current criteria ensure equitable access to services
