

1-1.B REFERRING ORGANIZATIONS

REQUIREMENT

1-1.B The site establishes organizational relationships with community providers for referrals. A formal Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the HFA site and local child welfare office is required for sites approved to use HFA's Child Welfare Protocols.

How is this rated?

- Exceeds Standard (3) No 3 rating indicator for 1-1.B.
- Meets Standard (2) The <u>site identifies organizations</u> where families can be referred from, and agreements (formal or informal) are in place. An MOU is established with the local child welfare office if approved for HFA's Child Welfare Protocols.
- Does not Yet Meet Standard (1) The site does not yet:
 - · Identify organizations,

- · Have established relationships with identified organizations, or
- Have an MOU if approved to use HFA's Child Welfare Protocols
