



6-3.B CHEERS USED TO ASSESS PCI

REQUIREMENT

6-3.B The site partners with parents to assess parent-child interaction (PCI), attachment, and bonding with families, utilizing CHEERS on all home visits.

How is this rated?

- Exceeds Standard (3) Staff partner with parents to assess PCI, attachment, and bonding with all families using CHEERS on all home visits (except when CCI is completed). At least 1 domain is documented during the 2nd trimester and 2 in the 3rd and after birth.
- **Meets Standard (2)** In the past, staff did not partner with family to assess PCI, attachment, and bonding using CHEERS; however, <u>recent practice</u> (<u>past 3 months</u>) indicates this is <u>now occurring</u>.
- Does not Yet Meet Standard (1) Staff do not yet partner with families to assess PCI, attachment, and bonding using CHEERS.

DOCUMENTATION REVIEW

Every Home Visit Record includes the required	CHEERS (e.g., 2 domains) documentation with:
Objective language	Both positive and concerning CHEERS (not necessarily on the same visit)
3-part framework	Frequency (most, some, once)
Domain alignment and rotation (ensure all are documented over time)	

TIPS FOR COMPLETING

- Prenatal CHEERS should be objective but do not require all
 3 steps see <u>HFA Prenatal Guide</u> for guidance
- CHEERS is not required when the FROG or CCI is conducted
- Over time, both positive and concerning CHEERs should be documented to reflect an accurate picture of interactions
