



6-3.C PCI ADDRESSED AND PROMOTED

REQUIREMENT

6-3.C The site addresses concerning parent-child interaction and promotes nurturing parent-child interactions (PCI), attachment, and bonding with all families based on observations made using CHEERS.

How is this rated?

- Exceeds Standard (3) Staff <u>address PCI concerns and promote nurturing PCI</u>, attachment, and bonding with all families based on CHEERS observations.
- **Meets Standard (2)** In the past, staff did not address/promote PCI with all families; however <u>recent practice</u> (past 3 months) indicates this is <u>now occurring</u>.
- Does not Yet Meet Standard (1) Staff do not yet address PCI concerns and promote nurturing PCI, attachment, and bonding with all families using CHEERS.

DOCUMENTATION REVIEW

Every Home Visit Record include

	Use of at least one reflective strategy to address or promote PCI based on
	CHEERS
1	Demonstration of staff understanding and appropriate use of reflective strategies

TIPS FOR COMPLETING

- Staff are only required to document 1 reflective strategy based on CHEERS per visit (not required when the CCI is completed)
- Staff who have completed Baby TALK training may use curriculum strategies instead such as Narrating Behavior (NB), Meaning Making (MM), Supporting Parental Mastery (SPM), or Pivot.
 - \circ E&W = NB + MM
 - ATP/SATP = SPM
- All concerning CHEERS should be addressed in the HVR
